That makes it less appealing for people to visit these museums.

In 2013 2.6 million people attended ~~the~~ British Museum and in 2017 5.6 million visited. So the amount of people attending have doubled in four years. ³²

~~The~~ Science museums on the other hand received 2.2 million less than 2013 to 2017. ³⁴

Drawing from the data given by Social Statistics we can say that people don't want to pay to visit museums. ²⁰

A visit to a museum should be free and that will appeal more to people. Also museums should organise events so now people would attend. ²⁵

Museums should know on the condition that paying for a visit will make less people attend. But even the less we can see that the interest to visit museums and galleries is growing. ³³
