I'm writing a report on the attendance of museums and galleries in England and I want to give some recommendations that could help to increase people's attendance of these places of interest.

According to the statistics of visits to national museums and galleries, I can say that from 2013 to 2017 the attendance of the British Museum and the Tate Gallery has doubled (even more than doubled; the attendance to the British Museum has increased in 2,2 times and to the Tate Gallery - in 2,4 times!) While the attendance to the National Gallery has increased only in 1,8 times.

But it's not bad at all, especially if you take a look on the statistics of visits to the Natural History Museum and the Science Museum - their attendance has decreased in 2,3 and 3 times from 2013 to 2015! It has started to decrease after 2014, when these museums introduced admission charges. But from 2015 to 2017 visits to the both museums has increased a little - by 20% per one.

The best recommendation I can give is to rig a theft of one of exponents. The same situation happened two weeks ago - one of the pictures in the Tretyakov Gallery was stolen and this incident has appealed⁺ people to this gallery. Another way to draw⁺ on the people's interest is to make "free of charge" days or just some sales for tickets.

I think the attendance of museums will exist forever, because they are the best way to learn world's history.
