Overall, we can see a significant rise of people who decided to visit museums and galleries. The number of visitors for most of them has <sup>50</sup> increased as much as two times, going from 2.6 mln in 2013 to 5.6 mln in 2017 for <sup>the</sup> British museum. Those respectively big numbers can be explained by modern popularization of science and culture, that resulted in now substantial majority of citizens in developed countries to take even a slight interest <sup>50</sup> in cultural aspect, therefore seeing more appeal in going to different museums and galleries.

Although in free-to-enter facilities we had seen an increased amount of visitors, for those who implemented a payment for entrance, it was a complete contrary sight. From 3.8 mln when it was free, <sup>50</sup> Science museum has seen a drop in numbers to as low as 1.6 mln in 2017. Meaning, that most people are not willing to pay big money to enter visit museums. Though it's understandable, that museums and galleries, especially the modern ones, need to have a pay off for their efforts, but it has <sup>50</sup> been shown that to make science and culture more accessible, the price must be cut down or removed entirely.
